COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 158, L.D. 372, "An Act To Provide
Maine Children Access to Affordable Health Care"

Amend the bill in section 3 in §3174-T by striking out all of subsection 2-B (page 3,
lines 30 to 36 in L.D.) and inserting the following:

2-B. Noncitizens. Health care coverage under the Cub Care program is available to
a person:

A. Who is under 21 years of age;

B. Who is not a citizen of the United States, but is legally admitted to the United States;

C. Who is not eligible for Medicaid;

D. Whose family income is below the maximum eligibility level established under
subsection 2, paragraphs A and B; and

E. Who meets the requirements in subsection 2, paragraph C.

All the requirements of eligibility, program administration, benefit delivery and outreach
established in this section apply to a person eligible for the Cub Care program in accordance
with this subsection.'

Amend the bill by inserting after section 6 the following:

'Sec. 7. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
allocations are made.

SUMMARY

This amendment, which is the majority report of the committee, expands eligibility under the Cub Care program to noncitizen children who are legally admitted to the United States and who are not otherwise eligible for Medicaid if they meet the eligibility requirements of the program. The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) of \$5,457,411 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$10,631,464 in fiscal year 2022-23 due to adjustment of the eligibility requirements and elimination of premiums in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) for the DHHS to contract for outreach activities and for required technology changes. Other Special Revenue Funds, Federal Expenditures Fund and Federal Block Grant Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
