1 2 3	1. It keeps the maximum eligibility level for family income under the Cub Care program at 200% of the federal poverty level, which is the amount established in current law.
4 5	<ol><li>It removes the provision that eligibility is not subject to an asset test because current rules do not make eligibility subject to an asset test.</li></ol>
6 7	3. It removes the requirement to provide coverage to persons 19 and 20 years of age and to noncitizens under 21 years of age.
8 9	4. It removes the requirement that the Department of Health and Human Services seek federal funds for outreach activities and removes the goal of outreach activities.
10	The amendment also adds an appropriations and allocations section.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$120,850 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$207,080 in fiscal year 2022-23 due the elimination of premiums in the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) and for required technology changes. Other Special Revenue Funds and Federal Block Grant Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
