1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §2404, sub-§4, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 253, §1, is amended
3	to read:
4	4. Maximum virtual public charter school enrollment. The total enrollment at all
5	virtual public charter schools authorized by the commission may not exceed 1,000 students
6	2% of the total statewide enrollment for the grade levels served by the virtual public charter
7	schools.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill changes the maximum total enrollment at all virtual public charter schools
10	from 1,000 students to 2% of the total statewide enrollment for the grade levels served by
11	the virtual public charter schools.
