1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 7 MRSA §3972, sub-§1, ¶B, as amended by PL 2017, c. 131, §1, is further amended to read:
4 5	B. Sell, display, raffle, give away or offer for sale to the public any live fowl ₅ or turtles or rabbits under 8 weeks of age in lots of less than 2;
6	Sec. 2. 7 MRSA §3972, sub-§1, ¶B-1 is enacted to read:
7 8	<u>B-1.</u> Sell, display, raffle, give away or offer for sale to the public any rabbits under 6 weeks of age in lots of less than 2;
9	SUMMARY
10 11	This bill changes the age at which a rabbit may be sold, displayed, raffled, given away or offered for sale to the public from 8 weeks of age to 6 weeks of age.
