5 6 7 8	This bill would direct the Department of Environmental Protection to create a plan to compost all of the State's food waste and bagged grass clippings, leaves and other woody debris in convenient places in each of the counties of the State. The department would be directed to submit this plan and implementing legislation for presentation to the Second
