COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 299, L.D. 415, "Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services To Increase MaineCare Reimbursement Rates for Targeted Case Management Services To Reflect Inflation"

Amend the resolve by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'Resolve, Directing the Department of Health and Human Services To Increase MaineCare Reimbursement Rates for Targeted Case Management Services and To Expand Eligibility for Targeted Case Management Services for Adults with Substance Use Disorder'**

Amend the resolve by inserting after the 7th indented paragraph after the title the following:

**'Whereas, in 2020 the State experienced an increase in fatal overdoses and is on track in 2021 to exceed the overdose deaths from the prior year; and**

**Whereas, accessing necessary treatment services for substance use disorder is vital to recovery and to saving lives; and'**

Amend the resolve in the 8th indented paragraph after the title in the last 2 lines (page 1, lines 21 and 22 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "no later than April 1, 2021" and inserting the following: 'and to expand eligibility for targeted case management services for adults with substance use disorder'

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the first line (page 1, line 27 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "rules" the following: **'for reimbursing targeted case management services'**

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 28 and 29 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "no later than April 1, 2021,"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "rates" the following: 'effective April 1, 2021'

8 of Health and Human Services shall amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits  
9 Manual, Chapter II, Section 13.03-4 to remove from the eligibility requirements for  
10 targeted case management services for adults with substance use disorder the provision  
11 regarding pregnancy, living with minor children and intravenous drug use. Rules adopted  
12 pursuant to this section are routine technical rules pursuant to the Maine Revised Statutes,  
13 Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$1,661,113 in fiscal year 2020-21, \$6,604,348 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$6,590,399 in fiscal year 2022-23 for additional targeted case management services for adults with substance use disorder and to increase rates for targeted case management services to reflect cost increases from 2010 to 2020. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations are also included in this bill for the FMAP match.
