4 5 6	K. Digital, electronic, audio, video or other recording of law enforcement interviews of suspects <u>and witnesses</u> in murder, Class A, Class B and Class C crimes and the preservation of investigative notes and records in such cases;

8 9 10	Current law requires that law enforcement agencies adopt written policies for the recording of interviews of suspects in murder, Class A, Class B and Class C crimes. This bill extends that requirement to include recording of interviews of witnesses.
