Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting the following:

Sec. 4. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

EDUCATION, DEPARTMENT OF

State Mandate Reimbursement - Collective Bargaining N399

Initiative: Provides ongoing funds to reimburse certain local school administrative units for 90% of the legal and other costs to meet and negotiate within 10 days after a written notice from the other party is made due to the exception to the mutual obligation to meet requirement in a collective bargaining agreement being repealed.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment eliminates the General Fund appropriation of \$52,200 in fiscal year 2021-22.

As amended, this bill remains a funded State Mandate. It includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$52,200 per year beginning in fiscal year 2022-23 to a newly created State Mandate Reimbursement - Collective Bargaining program within the Department of Education to reimburse certain school administrative units for the cost to implement the requirements of this legislation.
