2 3	Sec. 1. 12 MRSA §6856, sub-§3-D, ¶D, as enacted by PL 2011, c. 175, §5, is amended to read:
4 5 6 7 8	D. A depuration certificate holder shall pay each municipality an amount equal to 50¢ \$2 for each bushel of soft-shelled clams taken in that municipality under the depuration certificate. When submitting payment to a municipality under this paragraph, the depuration certificate holder shall include a summary of reports submitted to the department pursuant to rules adopted under subsection 4.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12	This bill amends the laws concerning the shellfish depuration harvesting process to raise the rate of reimbursement paid to the municipality by the depuration certificate holder from 50 cents for each bushel of soft-shelled clams to \$2.00 for each bushel.
