- 1 **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not 2 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
- 3 **Whereas,** behavioral health services are an important service for an individual's 4 overall health and well-being; and
- 5 **Whereas,** rates of reimbursement for services create barriers to the abundance of 6 services provided;

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within
the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,
therefore,

11 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. Department of Health and Human Services to increase MaineCare rates. That, no later than July 1, 2021, the Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapter III, Section 65, Behavioral Health Services, Children's Home and Community Based Treatment, and Section 97, Appendix D, Principles of Reimbursement for Child Care Facilities, to increase reimbursement rates by 30%.

18 Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and
