12	Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:
13 14	'An Act Regarding the Citizen Members and the Complaint Review Committee of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy'
15	Amend the bill by striking out all of section 1 and inserting the following:
16	Sec. 1. 25 MRSA §2801-A, sub-§1-A is enacted to read:
17 18 19	1-A. Citizen member. "Citizen member" means a citizen, educator or municipal official appointed to the board pursuant to section 2802 who is not and has never been a sworn member of a law enforcement agency.
20 21	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
22	SUMMARY
23 24 25 26	This amendment removes the section of the bill that expands the membership of the Board of Trustees of the Maine Criminal Justice Academy. The amendment defines "citizen member" of the board as an educator, municipal official or citizen member who i not and never has been a sworn member of a law enforcement agency.
