Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
Whereas, this legislation needs to take effect before the expiration of the 90-day period in order to remove the April 1, 2021 repeal of the requirement that the Public Utilities Commission arrange for a green power offer for electricity before that repeal takes effect; and
Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §3212-A, sub-§3, as amended by PL 2015, c. 25, §1, is repealed.
Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation takes effect when approved.
SUMMARY
This bill removes the repeal of the requirement that the Public Utilities Commission arrange for a green power offer for electricity.
