COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 425, L.D. 582, "An Act To Support the Fidelity and Sustainability of Assertive Community Treatment"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting the following:

**Sec. 5. Rulemaking.** The Department of Health and Human Services shall amend its rules governing the assertive community treatment, or ACT, program within 6 months after the effective date of this Act, with appropriate stakeholder involvement, to provide an initial authorization period of 6 months for clients meeting eligibility requirements for ACT and require reauthorization no more often than 6 months thereafter. Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.

**Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations.** The following appropriations and allocations are made.

3 **SUMMARY**

4 This amendment, which is the unanimous report of the committee, amends the rule-  
5 making directive to the Department of Health and Human Services to remove all of the  
6 rule-making changes proposed in the bill except the provision relating to the authorization  
7 period, which the amendment alters, changing from 12 months to 6 months the initial  
8 authorization period and the reauthorization period. The amendment also adds an  
9 appropriations and allocations section.

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$61,063 in fiscal year 2020-21, \$625,875 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$624,228 in fiscal year 2022-23 for the Department of Health and Human Services to increase reimbursement rates under rule Chapter 101: MaineCare Benefits Manual, Chapters II and III, Section 17 for assertive community treatment by 25% and for technology changes. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be included for the FMAP match and Other Special Revenue Funds allocations for the service provider tax.
