Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the

'An Act To Enhance Tribal-State Collaboration and To Revise the Tax Laws
Regarding the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians, the Passamaquoddy Tribe and the
Penobscot Nation'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of Parts I and J.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

20

This amendment changes the title and removes Part J of Committee Amendment "A,"
which authorizes the Department of Public Safety, Gambling Control Unit to regulate
sports wagering in the State, including the awarding of up to 10 total facility sports
wagering licenses to conduct in-person sports wagering in the State, and allows each of the
State's 4 federally recognized Indian tribes to apply for a single mobile sports wagering
license to conduct sports wagering. The amendment also removes Part I of Committee
Amendment "A," which sets forth the legislative findings and purposes underlying Part J.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the provisions of Committee Amendment "A" related to sports wagering. The appropriations and revenues associated with sports wagering are removed from the bill.
