The department shall reimburse for ostomy equipment and supplies at no less than 85% of the 2021 federal Medicare reimbursement rate for the equipment and supplies as long as the rate is no lower than the rate reimbursed by the department as of January 1, 2021.

## Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill includes General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$9,313 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$18,625 in fiscal year 2022-23 to increase the rates for ostomy equipment to 85% of the Medicare rate. Federal Expenditures Fund allocations will also be required for the FMAP match.
