SUMMARY 27 28 This amendment, which is the minority report of the committee, limits the purpose for 29 which the Governor convenes the Legislature to deliberating the continuation of the state 30 of emergency. ## Legislative Cost/Study

Current law allows the Legislature to terminate a state of emergency by joint resolution at any time. The bill requires a 2/3 vote of the Legislature in order for the Governor to extend a state of emergency. The Legislature's baseline budget for 2022-2023 includes funds for the Legislature to meet in special session on 2 days each fiscal year following the applicable statutory deadline. Whether or not there are sufficient funds to cover the cost of holding a special session for the purpose of extending a state of emergency will depend on the number of times the Legislature is required to convene in special session during the interim.
