1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 19-A MRSA §652, sub-§7, as amended by PL 2019, c. 340, §10, is repealed.
3 4	Sec. 2. 19-A MRSA §652, sub-§8, as amended by PL 2019, c. 340, §11 and c. 535, §1, is further amended to read:
5 6	8. Parties under 16 <u>18</u> years of age. The clerk or State Registrar of Vital Statistics may not issue a marriage license to a person under 16 <u>18</u> years of age.
7	SUMMARY
8 9	This bill amends the law to completely prohibit marriage of any person under 18 years of age.
