Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to develop 17 recommendations regarding nonwater-dependent floating structures on the 18 State's waters. Resolved: That the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and 19 Forestry shall establish an interagency working group to develop recommendations, 20 including suggested legislation, to define and regulate nonwater-dependent floating 21 structures on coastal and inland waters. The department shall consult with the Department 22 of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and other state and federal agencies as needed and seek 23 input from a statewide municipal association and a statewide harbor masters association 24 that represents Maine harbor masters. The department shall submit a report with findings 25 and recommendations, including suggested legislation, to the joint standing committee of 26 the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters no 27 later than January 1, 2024. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having 28 jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters may submit a bill to the 29 Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature based on the subject matter of the report.' 30 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 31 number to read consecutively. 32 **SUMMARY** 33 This amendment, which replaces the bill with a resolve, directs the Department of 34 Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry to establish an interagency working group to 35 develop recommendations, including suggested legislation, to define and regulate

nonwater-dependent floating structures on coastal and inland waters. The department is required to consult with the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife and other state and federal agencies as needed and seek input from a statewide municipal association and a statewide harbor masters association that represents Maine harbor masters. The department is required to submit a report with findings and recommendations to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters no later than January 1, 2024. The joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over agriculture, conservation and forestry matters is authorized to submit a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 131st Legislature based on the subject matter of the report.
