Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 37-B MRSA §742, sub-§1, ¶C, as amended by PL 2019, c. 617, Pt. H, §1, is further amended by amending subparagraph (12) to read:

(12) Take whatever action is necessary to abate, clean up or mitigate whatever danger may exist within the affected area. Any action taken under this subparagraph that would directly result in the temporary or permanent closure of a business or a civic or religious organization must be approved by a 2/3 vote of the membership of the Legislative Council; and

SUMMARY

This bill requires any action taken pursuant to an emergency proclamation of the Governor intended to abate, clean up or mitigate whatever danger may exist within an affected area to be approved by a 2/3 vote of the Legislative Council if the action would directly result in the temporary or permanent closure of a business or a civic or religious organization.
