16 17	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
18 19	Whereas, the issue of violence against hospital and medical staff has increased in recent years; and
20 21	Whereas, hospitals are unclear what the options are for prosecution when victims are unwilling to bring cases; and
22 23 24 25	Whereas, the work of the Task Force To Study the Process for Bringing Crimina Cases in Situations of Violence against Health Care Workers needs to begin prior to 90 days after adjournment in order for the task force to have enough time to review the circumstances and make recommendations; and
26 27 28 29	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now therefore, be it'
30	Amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 1 and 2 and inserting the following:
31 32 33	'Sec. 1. Task force established. Resolved: That the Task Force To Study the Process for Bringing Criminal Cases in Situations of Violence against Health Care Workers, referred to in this resolve as "the task force," is established.

### Legislative Cost/Study

The general operating expenses of this study are projected to be \$2,250 in fiscal year 2021-22. The Legislature's budget for the 2022-2023 biennium includes \$10,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$10,000 in fiscal year 2022-23 for costs of legislative studies, as well as \$21,260 of balances carried over from prior years for this purpose. Whether these amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature. The additional costs of providing staffing assistance to the study during the interim can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted staff resources.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Any additional costs to the District Attorneys Office within the Office of the Attorney General and to the Judicial Department to serve as members of the task force are assumed to be minor and can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
