**An Act To Include an Emergency Reimbursement Rate Review  
Process in Rate Setting by the Department of Health and Human  
Services**

1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §3173**, as amended by PL 1997, c. 676, §1 and PL 2003, c. 689,  
3 Pt. B, §6, is further amended by adding after the 15th paragraph a new paragraph to read:

4 The department shall establish a process of emergency reimbursement rate review to  
5 be used at times of extraordinary circumstances. The department shall establish in rule  
6 standards for extraordinary circumstances and procedures for allowing providers or their  
7 representative associations to request an emergency review.

8 **Sec. 2. Department of Health and Human Services to establish emergency**  
9 **rate review process.** As part of the efforts of the Department of Health and Human  
10 Services to establish a rate-setting procedure, the department shall include a process for  
11 emergency reimbursement rate review to be used at times of extraordinary circumstances.  
12 The department shall determine what constitutes extraordinary circumstances, except that  
13 they must include state and municipal requirements for increased minimum wages and  
14 other increases to wages that affect MaineCare reimbursement rates and widespread  
15 outbreaks of disease that require additional resources to offer services. The process must  
16 include a method for individual providers or their representative associations to request an  
17 emergency review, deadlines that ensure a timely response from the department to requests  
18 and requirements for clear communications on acceptance or decline of requests for review.

19 **SUMMARY**

20 This bill requires the Department of Health and Human Services to establish a process  
21 for emergency reimbursement rate review to be used at times of extraordinary  
22 circumstances. This process must be established as part of the current rate review process  
23 undertaken by the department.
