COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 481, L.D. 654, "An Act To Create a 24-hour Shelter Capital Project Funding Program"

Amend the bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

HOUSING AUTHORITY, MAINE STATE

Twenty-four-hour Shelter Capital Project Program Fund N369

Initiative: Provides one-time funds to establish and implement the Twenty-four-hour Shelter Capital Project program established in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 30-A, chapter 201, subchapter 14. This funding is supplemental to funding for the Maine State Housing Authority's emergency shelter and housing assistance program.
