1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 14 MRSA §6030-H is enacted to read:
3 4	§6030-H. Protection from power outages for tenants 65 years of age and older in subsidized housing
5 6	1. <b>Definition; subsidized apartment.</b> For the purposes of this section, "subsidized apartment" has the same meaning as in section 6030-F, paragraph C.
7 8 9 10	2. Secondary source of electricity required. A landlord or other person who on behalf of a landlord enters into a lease or tenancy at will agreement for a subsidized apartment with a tenant 65 years of age or older shall ensure that the apartment is equipped with a secondary source of electricity in the event of a power outage.
11 12 13 14 15	3. Breach of implied warranty. The failure of a landlord or other person who on behalf of a landlord enters into a lease or tenancy at will agreement for a subsidized apartment with a tenant 65 years of age or older to ensure that the subsidized apartment is equipped with a secondary source of electricity in the event of a power outage is a breach of the implied warranty of fitness for human habitation in accordance with section 6021.
