COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 267, L.D. 680, "Resolve, To Reestablish the Task Force To Study the Creation of a Comprehensive Career and Technical Education System"

Amend the resolve in section 2 in subsection 3 in paragraph A in the first line (page 1, line 40 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "a community college" and inserting the following: 'the Maine Community College System'

Amend the resolve by striking out all of section 7 and inserting the following:

'Sec. 7. Report. Resolved: That, no later than November 2, 2022, the task force shall submit a report that includes its findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, for presentation to the First Regular Session of the 131st Legislature.'

Amend the resolve by inserting after section 8 the following:

'Sec. 9. Appropriations and allocations. Resolved: That the following appropriations and allocations are made.

Legislative Cost/Study

The general operating expenses of this study are projected to be \$1,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$1,250 in fiscal year 2022-23. The bill requires the study be funded from outside funding and therefore Other Special Revenue Funds allocations of \$1,000 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$1,250 in fiscal year 2022-23 to the Legislature are provided for the costs of the study. The additional costs of providing staffing assistance to the study during the interim can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted staff resources.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Additional costs to the Department of Education, the State Board of Education, the Maine Community College System and the University of Maine System to have representatives serve on the task force can be absorbed within existing budgeted resources.
