SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 508,
L.D. 696, "An Act To Prohibit Solitary Confinement in Maine's Corrections System"

Amend the amendment by striking out the substitute title and replacing it with the following:

'An Act To Remove the Term "Solitary Confinement" from Statute'

Amend the amendment by striking out the 2nd paragraph after the title (page 1, lines 13 and 14 in amendment) and inserting the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 1, 2 and 3.'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 1.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment strikes the provision of Committee Amendment "A" that adds a definition of "solitary confinement." This amendment retains from the bill only that provision that removes the term "solitary confinement" from the Maine Revised Statutes.
