SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 512,  
L.D. 700, "An Act To Promote Economic Development and Outdoor Recreation through  
Investment in State Parks"

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Amend the amendment by striking out the first paragraph after the title (page 1, line 11  
in amendment) and inserting the following:

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'Amend the bill in section 1 in the first paragraph in the 6th and 7th lines (page 1, lines  
9 and 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "All revenue in excess of \$4,500,000" and  
inserting the following: 'After 2025, all revenue in excess of \$5,476,268'

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Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 2.

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Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

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**SUMMARY**

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This amendment changes the excess revenue threshold for revenue from user fees and  
other payments to accrue to a nonlapsing dedicated revenue account to be used for capital  
improvements at State Parks and historic sites from \$4,500,000 to \$5,476,268 and provides  
that that accrument begins after 2025.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

Adding an effective date of July 1, 2025 reverses all impacts from the bill until that date. After that date the threshold for diverting General Fund revenue to the Parks-General Operations program for improvements at state parks and historic sites is raised from \$4,500,000 in the bill to \$5,476,268.
