1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 5 MRSA §17806, sub-§1, ¶ A , as amended by PL 2015, c. 334, §1, is further amended to read:
4 5 7 8 9 10	A. Except as provided in paragraphs A-1 and A-2, whenever there is a percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index from July 1st to June 30th, the board shall automatically make an equal percentage increase in retirement benefits, beginning in September, up to a maximum annual increase of 3%. Effective July 1, 2011, the increase applies to that portion of the retirement benefit up to \$20,000, which amount must be indexed in subsequent years by the same percentage adjustments granted under this paragraph and paragraph A-2.

12 13 14	This bill provides that cost-of-living increases for retired state employees and teachers and their beneficiaries apply to a retiree's entire retirement benefit instead of only to the first \$20,000 of the retirement benefit.
