2	Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §15009 is enacted to read:
3	§15009. Extracurricular sports
4 5 6 7	A school administrative unit may not receive funds under this Part except for funds under chapter 603-A unless the school administrative unit maintains a program of extracurricular sports that includes a sport for which there is at that school administrative unit a sufficient number of students willing to participate.
8	SUMMARY
9 10 11	This bill requires a school administrative unit, in order to receive state education funding, to offer a program of extracurricular sports if there is a sufficient number of students willing to participate.
