SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 276,  
L.D. 711, "An Act To Allow Certain Police Officers To Return to Participation in the  
Maine Public Employees Retirement System"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the substitute title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the Legislature do not  
become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** this legislation must take effect as soon as possible to allow certain  
employees sufficient time to make the election to return to the Maine Public Employees  
Retirement System, as permitted by this legislation; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within  
the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as  
immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now,  
therefore,'


Amend the amendment by adding after section 4 the following:

**'Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this legislation  
takes effect when approved.'

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or  
section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment adds an emergency preamble and emergency clause.
