2	Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §10105, sub-§8 is enacted to read:
3 4 5 6	8. Acquisitions, ownership and operation of facilities. In carrying out the purposes of this chapter and in accordance with this Title, the trust may acquire, own and operate electric generation facilities, energy storage systems as defined in section 3481, subsection 6 and transmission and distribution plants.
7	SUMMARY
8 9 10	This bill allows the Efficiency Maine Trust to acquire, own and operate electric generation facilities, energy storage systems and transmission and distribution plants to carry out its purposes and in accordance with the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 35-A.
