2 **Parks and Lands and Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make**
3 **information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for each parcel**
4 **of recreational land. Resolved:**

5 That the Department of Agriculture, Conservation
6 and Forestry, Bureau of Parks and Lands and the Department of Inland Fisheries and
7 Wildlife shall make information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for
8 each parcel of land under the bureau's jurisdiction as described under the Maine Revised
9 Statutes, Title 12, section 1803 and for each parcel of land under the jurisdiction of the
10 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The bureau and the Department of Inland
11 Fisheries and Wildlife shall provide information on how to access activities allowed and
12 applicable rules. The bureau and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife shall
13 make such information readily accessible to the general public, including, but not limited
14 to, on the bureau's and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife's publicly accessible
websites.

15 **SUMMARY**

16 This resolve requires the Department of Agriculture, Conservation and Forestry,
17 Bureau of Parks and Lands and the Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make
18 information available on activities allowed and applicable rules for each parcel of land
19 under the bureau's jurisdiction and for each parcel of land under the jurisdiction of the
20 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife. The resolve requires the bureau and the
21 Department of Inland Fisheries and Wildlife to make the information readily accessible to
22 the general public.
