SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 280, L.D. 729, "An Act To Provide Transparency Regarding State Contracts during a State of Emergency"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 4 in the 3rd line (page 1, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "72 hours" and inserting the following: '30 days'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment amends the bill to change the time period, from 72 hours to 30 days, within which the Governor must publish and make publicly available the complete terms and text of certain contracts entered into by the State pursuant to the powers granted the Governor during an emergency.
