1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §403-B** is enacted to read:

3 **§403-B. Public proceedings of municipal agencies through remote access**

4 **1. Remote access.** Notwithstanding any provision of law or municipal charter
5 provision or ordinance to the contrary, any board, commission, agency or authority of a
6 municipality subject to this subchapter may conduct a public proceeding through
7 telephonic, video, electronic or other similar means of remote participation under the
8 following conditions:

9 A. The board, commission, agency or authority of a municipality determines that
10 participation by the public may be through telephonic, video, electronic or other similar
11 means of remote participation;

12 B. Notice of the public proceeding has been given in accordance with section 406 and
13 includes the method by which the public may attend in accordance with paragraph A;

14 C. Each member of the board, commission, agency or authority of a municipality who
15 is participating in the public proceeding is able to hear and speak to all the other
16 members during the public proceeding, and members of the public attending the public
17 proceeding in the location identified in the notice given pursuant to paragraph A are
18 able to hear all members participating at other locations; and

19 D. All votes taken during the public proceeding are taken by roll call vote.

20 **2. Application to other proceedings.** This section does not apply to town meetings
21 held pursuant to Title 30-A, section 2524 or regional school unit budget meetings held
22 pursuant to Title 20-A, section 1482-A.

23 **SUMMARY**

24 This bill establishes in law the authorization for boards, commissions, agencies and
25 authorities of municipalities to conduct meetings remotely.
