1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

2 **Sec. 1. 1 MRSA §402, sub-§3, ¶C**, as amended by PL 1991, c. 773, §2, is further  
3 amended to read:

4 C. Legislative papers and reports until signed and publicly distributed in accordance  
5 with legislative rules, ~~and records, working papers, drafts and interoffice and~~  
6 ~~intraoffice memoranda used or maintained by any Legislator, legislative agency or~~  
7 ~~legislative employee to prepare proposed Senate or House papers or reports for~~  
8 ~~consideration by the Legislature or any of its committees during the legislative session~~  
9 ~~or sessions in which the papers or reports are prepared or considered or to which the~~  
10 ~~paper or report is carried over;~~

11 **SUMMARY**

12 The Freedom of Access Act currently provides that all records, working papers, drafts  
13 and interoffice and intraoffice memoranda used or maintained by any Legislator, legislative  
14 agency or legislative employee to prepare proposed Senate or House papers or reports for  
15 consideration by the Legislature or any of its committees are not considered public records  
16 during the legislative session or sessions in which the papers or reports are prepared or  
17 considered or to which the paper or report is carried over. This bill removes that provision.

18 The bill retains the provision in current law that exempts from the definition of "public  
19 records" legislative papers and reports until signed and publicly distributed.
