Enter or remain in or cause a projectile to enter or remain in <u>or allow the person's hunting dog to enter or remain in</u> any place in defiance of a lawful order not to enter or an order to vacate that was personally communicated to that person by the owner of the place or another authorized person.
8	SUMMARY
9	This bill prohibits a person engaging in an activity governed by the inland fisheries and
10	wildlife laws from allowing the person's hunting dog to enter or remain in any place in
11	defiance of a lawful order not to enter or an order to vacate that was personally
12	communicated to that person by the owner of the place or another authorized person.
