1 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

7 C. That it is prepared to meet those standards for educational programming and faculty
8 as established by the Department of Health and Human Services; ~~and.~~

11 **SUMMARY**

12 This bill simplifies requirements for approval of educational programs for certified
13 nursing assistants that are carried out by health care facilities by removing the requirement
14 that health care facilities seeking approval must demonstrate that an educational institution
15 cannot also provide such a program within 30 days of the application. Programs carried
16 out by health care facilities must still be approved by the Department of Health and Human
17 Services consistent with the curriculum approved by State Board of Nursing and must still
18 fulfill all standards established by the department and by the board.
