3 SUMMARY

This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.

This emergency bill proposes to direct the Department of Professional and Financial Regulation, Bureau of Insurance and the Department of Health and Human Services to develop a state nonprofit risk indemnification trust to provide liability insurance coverage for entities such as state-contracted providers of therapeutic foster care that are unable to obtain affordable coverage through ordinary means and when coverage is required by law or is necessary for the conduct of a public purpose. The bill proposes to indemnify nonprofit beneficiary organizations and their officers, directors and agents for financial loss due to the imposition of legal liability.
