4 5 6 7 8 9	This bill repeals the provision of law that provides that when an individual subject to an undischarged term of imprisonment is convicted of a crime committed while in execution of any term of imprisonment or of an attempt to commit a crime while in execution of any term of imprisonment, the sentence is not concurrent with any undischarged term of imprisonment and no portion of the nonconcurrent sentence may be suspended.
