Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

Sec. 1. 17-A MRSA §1609, as enacted by PL 2019, c. 113, Pt. A, §2, is repealed.

SUMMARY

This bill repeals the provision of law that provides that when an individual subject to an undischarged term of imprisonment is convicted of a crime committed while in execution of any term of imprisonment or of an attempt to commit a crime while in execution of any term of imprisonment, the sentence is not concurrent with any undischarged term of imprisonment and no portion of the nonconcurrent sentence may be suspended.
