Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing Other Special Revenue Funds deallocations of \$102,485 per year beginning in fiscal year 2021-22 to the Tick Laboratory and Pest Management Fund program and \$81,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2021-22 to the UM Cooperative Extension - Pesticide Education program, both within the University of Maine System, due to the programs no longer receiving revenue from the pesticide container fee in Title 36, chapter 725.

The bill includes a one-time General Fund appropriation of \$5,000 to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services to remove a line from the sales tax return.
