Amend the resolve in section 3 in the 4th line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Innovation, Development, Economic Advancement and Business" and inserting the following: 'Education and Cultural Affairs'

Amend the resolve in section 3 in the last paragraph in the first and 2nd lines (page 1, lines 35 and 36 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Innovation, Development, Economic Advancement and Business" and inserting the following: 'Education and Cultural Affairs'

Amend the resolve by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
