fo	Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the llowing:
	'Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §760, as enacted by PL 1995, c. 348, §1, is amended to read:
§7	60. Indemnification Liability
pa hi vc pr hi <u>ne</u>	A person is liable to the owner or operator of the overhead high-voltage line and 3rd arties, if any, for all <u>or part of the</u> damages to facilities, <u>and</u> injuries to persons and all <u>or</u> <u>art of the</u> costs, expenses and liabilities incurred by the owner or operator of the overhead gh-voltage lines and 3rd parties, if any, as a result of any contact with an overhead high- oltage line if the person causes, permits or allows any work or activity in violation of a ovision of this chapter and, as a result, a physical or electrical contact with an overhead gh-voltage line occurs. <u>The allocation of damages must be based on the comparative egligence of the parties as set forth in Title 14, section 156, except that employers of jured persons are immune from payment of damages to the extent provided under the faine Workers' Compensation Act of 1992.'</u>
nı	Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section imber to read consecutively.
SUMMARY	
ne pr	This amendment replaces the bill but retains the intent to limit the indemnification of e owner or operator of an overhead high-voltage line when the owner's or operator's egligence contributes to damages to facilities or injuries to persons. The amendment ovides that, to the extent employers are liable under workers' compensation laws when inployees are injured, employers are immune from the payment of damages under the

Overhead High-voltage Line Safety Act.
