COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 623, L.D. 855, "An Act Regarding the Issuance of a Birth Certificate Following a Gender Marker Change"

Amend the bill in section 6 in subsection 2-B in the 5th line (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "minor" the following: 'who is at least 16 years of age'

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is a minority report of the committee. It provides that a new birth certificate that indicates a change in the gender marker for a minor may be requested by a parent on behalf of the minor only if the minor is at least 16 years of age.
