HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 626,  
L.D. 858, "An Act To Expand Recovery Services to Persons on Probation"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

**'An Act To Limit Reincarceration for Persons on Probation' '**

Amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title (page 1, line 11 in amendment) by striking out the following: "all of sections 8 to 11" and inserting the following: 'everything after the enacting clause'

Amend the amendment in section 12 in §1814 in subsection 1 in the last line (page 2, line 33 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "community; or" the following: 'and'

Amend the amendment in section 12 in §1814 in subsection 3 in the last line (page 2, line 37 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and" and inserting the following: 'and'

Amend the amendment in section 12 in §1814 by striking out all of subsection 4 (page 2, lines 38 to 43 in amendment)

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 13.

Amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment deletes the provisions in the bill and committee amendment related to the possible referral of a person on probation to recovery services. It also removes the appropriations and allocations section.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment removes the section that allows for additional referrals to a certified recovery coach, a certified intentional peer support specialist or a qualified recovery support service as a condition of probation, which eliminates the need for the General Fund appropriations to the Department of Health and Human Services of \$595,329 in fiscal year 2021-22 and \$595,329 in fiscal year 2022-23.
