2	Sec. 1. 29-A MRSA §1611, sub-§2, ¶G is enacted to read:
3 4	G. For for-hire snowplow vehicles and vehicles used by landscaping or gardening companies:
5	(1) There is a combined single limit of \$125,000; or
6 7	(2) There is a split limit of \$50,000 per person or \$100,000 per occurrence for bodily injury liability and \$25,000 for property damage liability.
8	These vehicles must be covered by commercial policies.
9	SUMMARY
10 11 12 13	This bill adds for-hire snowplow vehicles and vehicles used by landscaping or gardening companies to the provision of law requiring a minimum amount of insurance. It requires the vehicles to be covered by commercial policies with a combined single limit of \$125,000 or a split limit of \$50,000 per person or \$100,000 per occurrence for bodily injury liability and \$25,000 for property damage liability.
