Remote instruction 15 1. **Definitions.** For the purposes of this section, unless the context otherwise indicates, "remote instruction" means instruction provided using audio or video transmission of a 16 17 teacher or of a classroom with a teacher and participating students. "Remote instruction" 18 includes real-time transmissions and recorded sessions. 19 2. Distribution or retransmission. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the 20 contrary and except as authorized by a public or private school for the purposes of remote 21 instruction, a person may not distribute or retransmit a recorded session of remote 22 instruction or any part thereof without the express written consent of the public or private 23 school. 24 3. Violation. A person who violates this section commits a civil violation for which 25 a fine of not less than \$200 nor more than \$500 may be adjudged. 26 Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section 27 number to read consecutively. **SUMMARY** 28 29 This amendment is the majority report. It replaces the bill.
