COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 682, L.D. 926, "An Act To Ban Biological Males from Participating in Women's Sports"

Amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting the following:

'Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §13 is enacted to read:

§13. Participation in female interscholastic or intramural sports

Only a student of the female sex may join or participate in an interscholastic or intramural athletic team or sports activity that is sponsored by an elementary or secondary school or postsecondary institution and is designated only for "females," "women" or "girls."

Amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment is a minority report of the committee. It replaces the bill but retains the original purpose of allowing only students of the female sex to participate in athletic teams and sports activities that are designated only for "females," "women" or "girls."
