1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3	Sec. 1. 22 MRSA §329, sub-§4, as amended by PL 2003, c. 469, Pt. C, §7, is repealed.
4 5	Sec. 2. 22 MRSA §329, sub-§7, as amended by PL 2007, c. 440, §§5 and 6, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:
6 7 8 9	7. Proposed use of major medical equipment. Any proposed use of major medical equipment to serve inpatients of a hospital, if the equipment is not located in a health care facility and was acquired without a certificate of need, except acquisitions exempt from review under subsection 3; and
10	SUMMARY
11 12 13	This bill repeals the requirements for a certificate of need issued by the Department of Health and Human Services for the offering of new health care services by a health care facility.
