COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 685, L.D. 929, "An Act To Address Funding for Maine Clean Elections"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 4 the following:

Sec. 5. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

**ETHICS AND ELECTION PRACTICES, COMMISSION ON GOVERNMENTAL
Governmental Ethics and Election Practices - Commission on 0414**

Initiative: Decreases allocations to the Maine Clean Election Fund due to the elimination of a biennial Consumer Price Index adjustment.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

Removing a requirement that the Commission on Governmental Ethics and Election Practices (the Commission) biennially adjust the amount of distributions made from the Maine Clean Election Fund based on the Consumer Price Index will reduce anticipated spending by \$380,725 in fiscal year 2021-22 and by \$280,750 in fiscal year 2022-23. Allocations to the Commission are reduced accordingly.
