inserting after the following: "Facilities," the following: 'Chapter III, Section 97, Appendix
C, Principles of Reimbursement for Medical and Remedial Service Facilities, and Chapter
III, Section 2, Adult Family Care Services,'

Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 6 and inserting the following:

Additionally, the funding for private nonmedical institution Appendix C facilities in section 2 in the committee amendment was incorrectly appropriated in the nursing facilities program account. That error was also corrected in this amendment.
